Miscellaneous

- New North Pointe entrance signs

The NPPOA board will be replacing the signs at all the entrances this spring. The current signs are original and 40 years old. They are wooden and are rotting.

The new signs are aluminum but will be very similar to the original ones.

- Lighthouses

The lighthouses on top of the south entrances are being replaced this spring. The original structures are falling apart. We are having new ones custom-made.

- Detention Basins

The subdivision has two detention basins for catching and slow releasing rain water. The large one is between Harbor Pointe Cir and Lake Shore Cir. The small one is between Harbor Pointe Cir and NorthPointe Elementary School at the east end of the grounds. In an effort to more effectively manage costs they may not be mowed each week. When the ground remains wet after a rain the mowers cannot get all the grass mowed without leaving significant ruts. The board works very hard to try and keep the water moving through the drainage pipes but leaves, rocks and mud create clogs each year. The cost to redo the drainage would be significant and well outside the budget.

There should not be trees/gardens planted in the detention basins. Tree roots will eventually interfere with the underground drainage pipes. Please respect property lines that back up to the detention basins.
