Fully staffed, the NPPOA Board of Directors is made up of ten members: two members from high and medium-density (condos, townhouses, and zero-lot lines) housing, and eight members from low-density housing (single family dwellings). Board members are elected for two-year terms, but members and officers may succeed themselves. The Board of Directors meets five times annually--typically the third Monday of the months of February, April, August, October, and November. The Annual Meeting is typically scheduled for the third Monday of April, and the Semi-Annual budgeting meeting is typically scheduled for the second Monday in November; both NPPOA member meetings are held immediately following the Board meetings on those dates.
